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#### I. <u>APPLICATION</u>:

SCCCMH Board

### II. <u>PURPOSE STATEMENT</u>:

St. Clair Community Mental Health (SCCCMH) shall ensure to define a standard set of procedure codes to be used throughout the entire region. These codes will be compliant with state and federal regulations.

#### III. <u>DEFINITIONS</u>:

- A. <u>CPT Current Procedural Terminology (CPT)</u>: A list by the American Medical Association of descriptive terms, five-digit numeric identifying codes and two-digit modifiers. These codes may be used to report services performed by health care providers.
- B. <u>Healthcare / Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS)</u>: A list of codes and modifiers to report professional services, procedures, and supplies.
- C. <u>HIPAA</u>: Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA).

### IV. <u>STANDARDS</u>:

- A. The Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) requires standardized procedure coding.
- B. CPT and HCPCS codes will be utilized for billing and encounter reporting which requires standardized units of measure.
- C. Definitions will be found within the Medicaid Provider Manual.
- D. Acceptable codes and relevant specification will be found on the PIHP/CMHSP Reporting HCPCS and Revenue Code List.

### V. <u>PROCEDURES</u>:

#### **Supports Services Director**

- 1. Reviews communication from MDHHS regarding acceptable codes and utilization.
- 2. Coordinates information with Medical Director and/or Program Director for inclusion into clinical protocols.
- 3. Distributes the listing of acceptable procedure codes for billing and reporting services.

### Data Management/SCCCMH/ Designee(s)

4. Updates respective software regarding changes in procedure codes.

### **SCCCMH / SCCCMH Subcontractors**

5. Documents services, procedures, and supplies accurately and timely using appropriate procedure codes.

### **SCCCMH / Provider Staff**

6. Utilizes the current MDHHS Procedure Code List.
