Why Corporate Compliance?

- ✓ Prevent and detect legal violations
- ✓ Help us do the right thing
- ✓ Provide guidance for ethical conduct
- ✓ Listen to concerns and find solutions
- ✓ Find ways to improve areas of risk

If You Suspect...

- ✓ Breach of confidentiality
- ✓ Conflicts of interest
- ✓ Improper billing practices
- ✓ Improper use of corporate property
- ✓ Vendor relationships

If you suspect compliance issues, make a report. Asking questions, raising concerns, or reporting possible improper conduct will not result in retaliation, and **reports can be made anonymously.**
